PROTECTING THE SHEEP FLOCK VISITORS WITH DIRECT SHEEP CONTACT

Keep animal health and well-being in mind when contacting sheep to protect their health.







Make sure you have permission to enter this operation. Follow all posted signs and biosecurity steps.



Respect the Line of Separation (LOS) between off-site and on-site traffic. Drive and park in designated areas.

Sign the visitors log and list any livestock contact or international travel.



Wear footwear that can be cleaned (manure removed) before entering animal areas and when moving between animal groups.



Clean equipment and supplies between different animal groups and operations to avoid disease spread.



Wear clean clothing that has not been around animals on other operations. Wash hands before contact, between groups, and after animal contact. Limit sheep contact to essential tasks.
